All materials not submitted electronically at the time of the application should be placed together in a packet and submitted by mail or in person at one time after the application has been submitted. Please leave sealed items in their original envelopes when putting them in the packet.

	Online Graduate Application – There is a non-refundable \$60 application fee. http://www.kennesaw.edu/graduate/admissions/onlineapplication.php
	Transcripts – Official transcripts from EACH College and/or University you have attended. Must be in sealed envelope from the institution or submitted to KSU electronically by the institution.
	GRE Score Report – Request that your scores be sent electronically to KSU (school code 5359). No department code is necessary. Minimum score of at least 286, combined verbal and quantitative (800 on the previous scale).
	Statement of Research Interests – Can be uploaded into the online application. Should strongly indicate <i>research</i> area of interest (to be done with a faculty member) and background information that may be relevant to succeeding in the program
	2 Letters of Recommendation - Can be sent electronically through the online application from persons familiar with the applicant's potential to complete successful graduate work.
